CIMIC Intercultural Advanced Liaison Course is designed to provide advanced communication and negotiation skills needed to enhance CIMIC Liaison capabilities in the cross cultural dimension of modern theatres of operations.

- b. Interact with Non Military Actors using communication and negotiation techniques;
- c. Develop effective CIMIC liaison activities.

4. Target Audience:

The course aims at training participants who are directly involved in NATO CIMIC & CMI activities or are interested in the matter. This includes personnel assigned or working as CIMIC operator in CIMIC units or HQ Staff. In addition, the course will be open to civilians, in particular those working in IOs, GOs or NGOs, with interest in CIMIC & CMI.

- a. Rank Level: OR-5 to OF-4 or equivalent civilians;
- b. Language Proficiency: STANAG English SLP 2222 (desired), STANAG English SLP 2221 (minimum).

5. Training Strategy:

Interactive lectures, role plays, open guided discussions.

From 25 to 32 students, both military and civilian from NATO nations and NATO partners.

The fees applied will be divided in two categories:

- For Military and Civilian personnel serving for the Ministry of Defence, coming from Participating Nations¹ (PNs) the cost is € 30,00 per day;
